



15 USING THE QUOTE MONTAGE WINDOW



THE QUOTE MONTAGE WINDOW (shown in Figure 15-1) gives you Level II quotes for listed NYSE and AMEX stocks. It displays the last traded price as well as current regional exchange quotes for the underlying symbol.

Figure 15-1 is an example of a Quote Montage window.

The Quote Montage window looks and works a lot like the NASDAQ Level II window, except that it displays regional stock exchange quotes for the underlying symbol instead of the market maker quotes displayed in a NASDAQ Level II window. You can customize a Quote Montage window to display a vertical ticker window, sort data in various ways and customize other display options. You can open a new Quote Montage window by right-clicking on a NYSE or AMEX symbol and selecting Quote Montage.

To create a new Quote Montage window

- 1 Right-click a NYSE or AMEX symbol from a Quote, Summary, or Portfolio window, then select Quote Montage from the right-click menu.

Once you have created a Quote Montage window, you can save it to recall later just as you can save other window types. You can also enter additional NYSE or AMEX symbols into the symbol box to retrieve regional stock quotes for those symbols.

Customizing the Quote Montage Window

You can customize the Quote Montage window by changing the symbol in the Symbol window, by linking the symbol to other windows in your layout, by sorting the data in various ways, by adding a vertical ticker, and by displaying last trade data.

You can also click the Properties toolbar to customize the data that is displayed on the vertical ticker, to set colors and fonts, and to display a visual market indicator.
